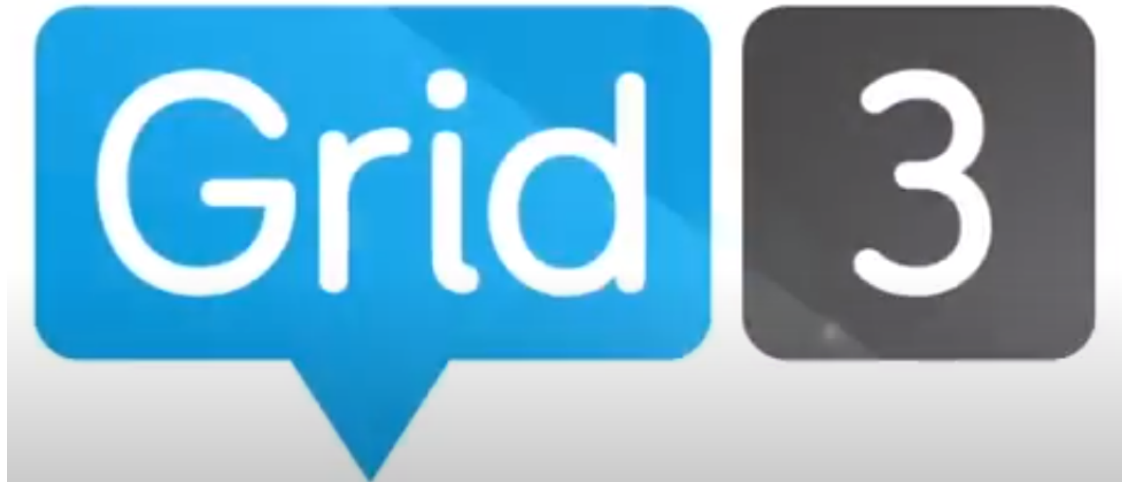
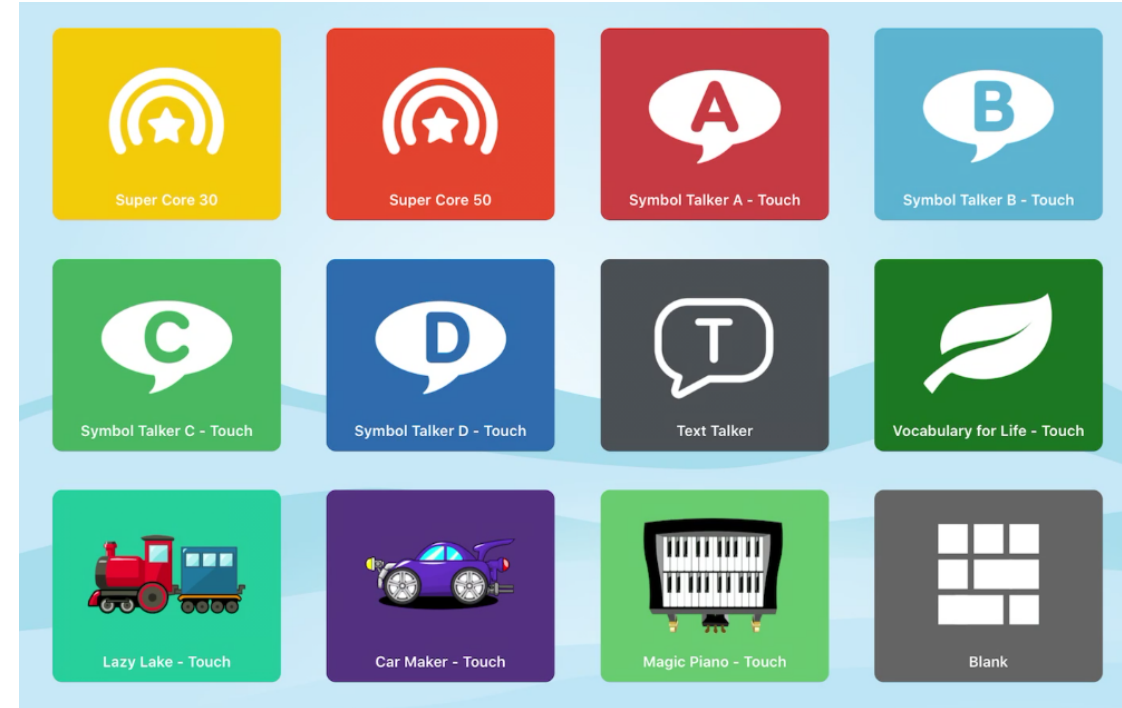

# General Information about Grid 3

- Designed to work with Grid Pad but can also work on other devices that meet requirements for storage and software
- Appropriate for a variety of ages and abilities
- Variety of grid pages – including core vocabulary pages, a variety of symbol sets that build on each other, games for training skills, text talkers
- Variety of symbol options – Widget Symbols, Symbol Stix, Picture Communication Symbols
- Back up using Dropbox and iCloud
- Free 60 day trial available

# Additional Information about Grid for iPad

- iPad version of the communication system Grid 3 by Smartbox
- Grid for iPad supports any iPad running iOS 11 and above.
- Price
  - Monthly subscription \$9.99
  - One time price \$399.99
- Free 30 day trial available

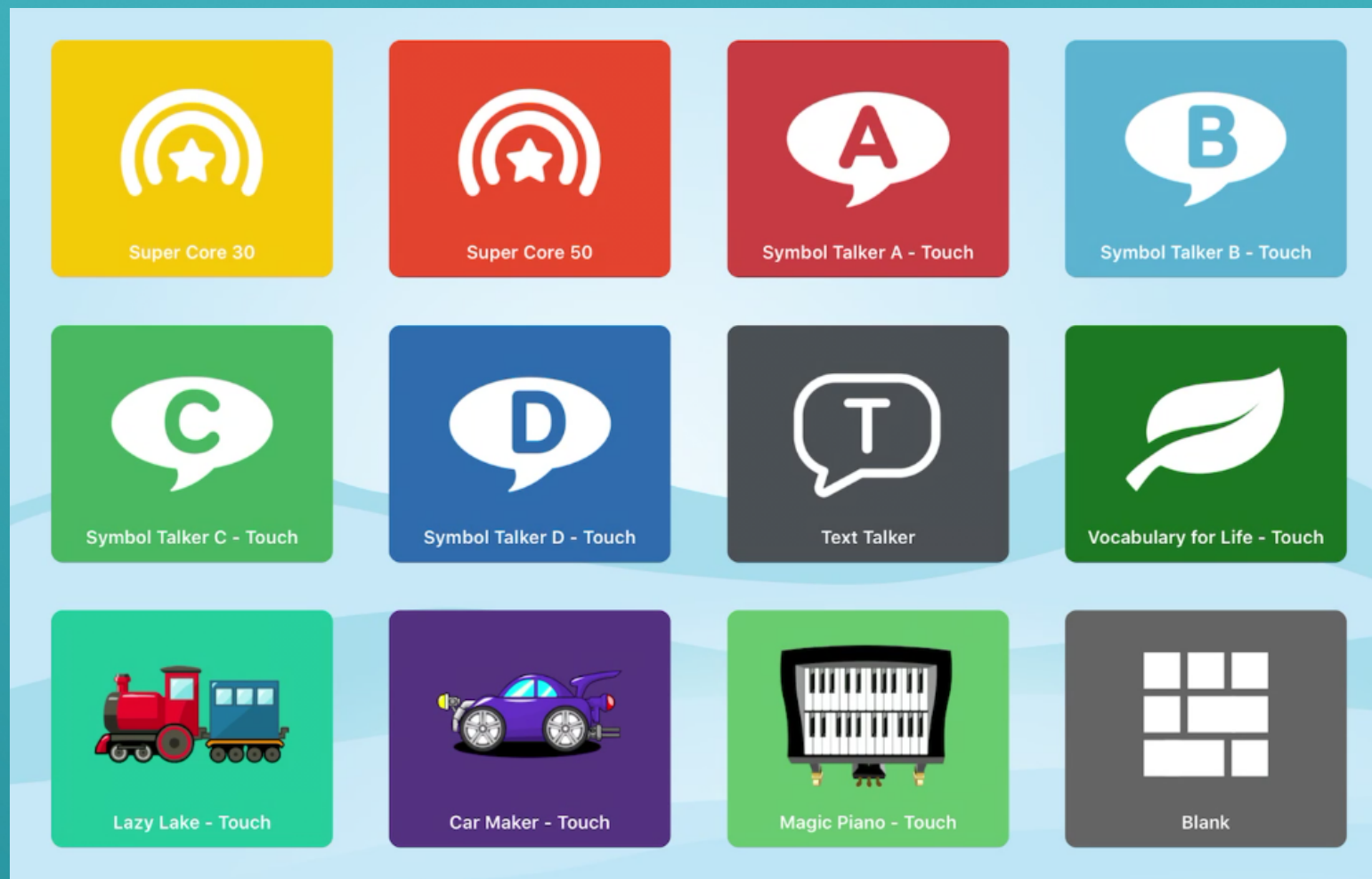

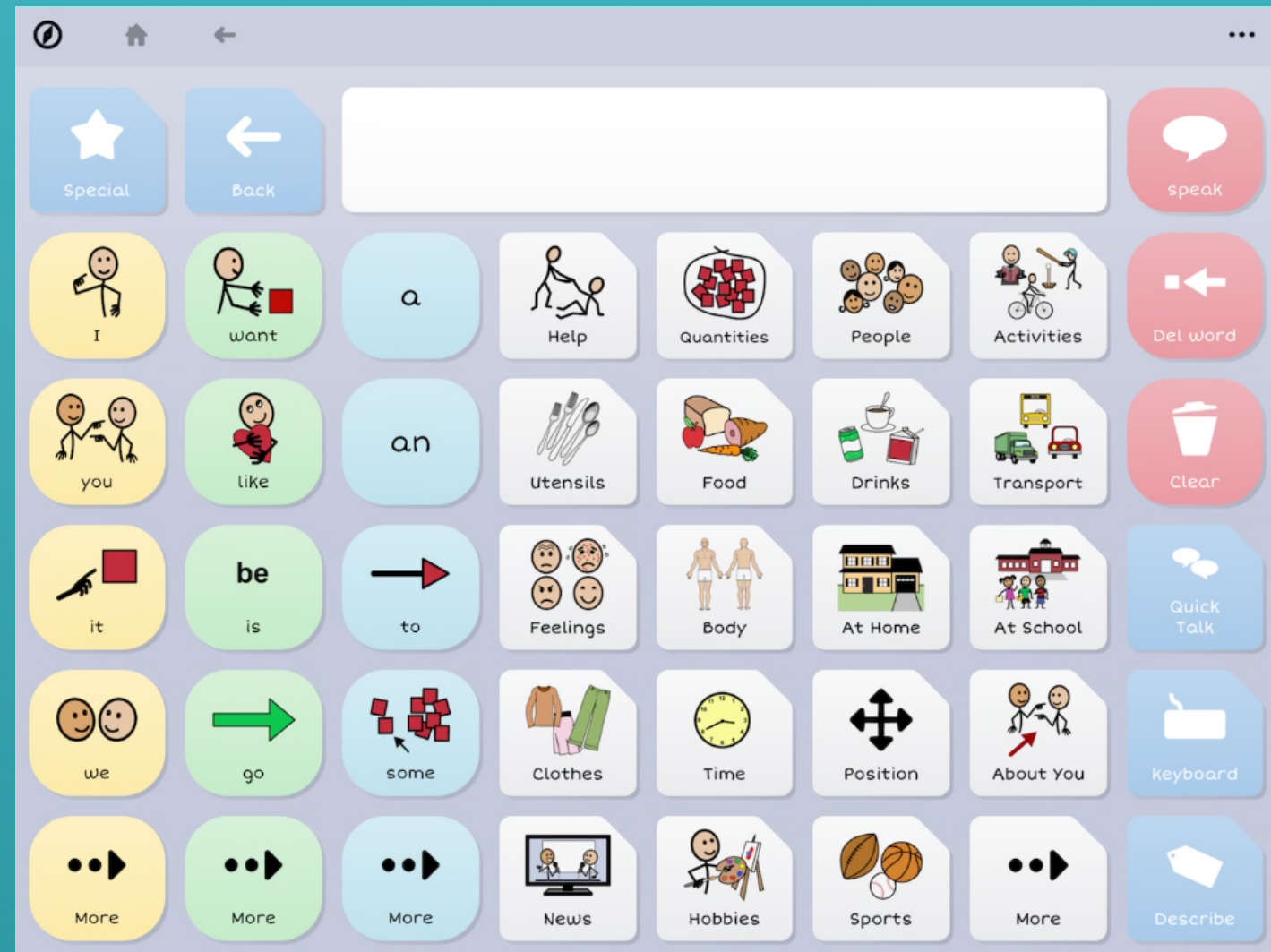

# Grid Layout

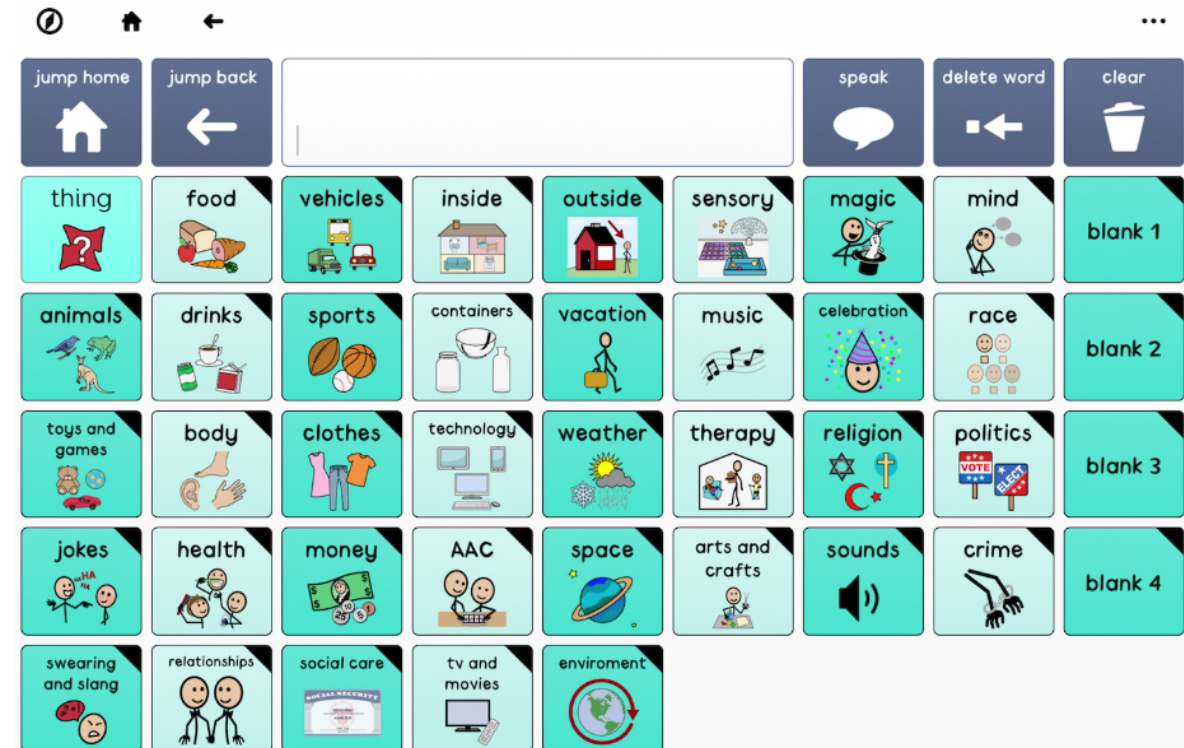
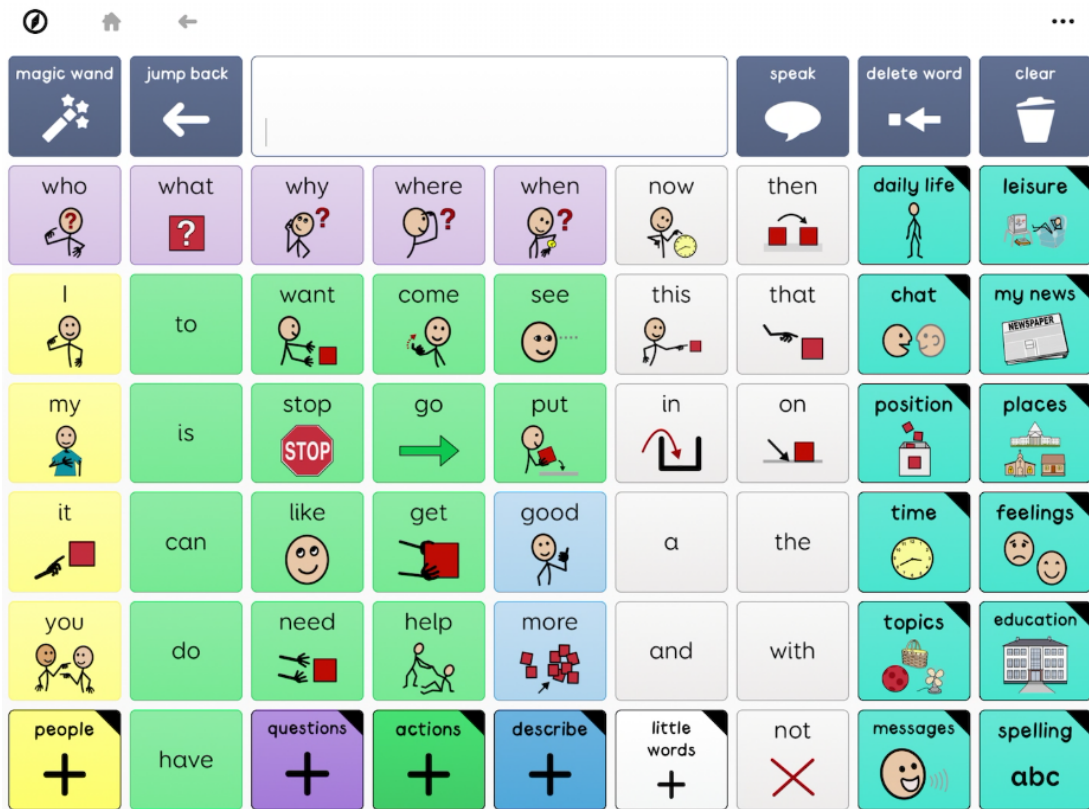
- Layouts vary by Grid and build upon each other – symbol talker A is simpler than B
- Designed to grow with the user
- Message window
- Sentence starters (green)
- Word lists (white)
- Command cells (red)

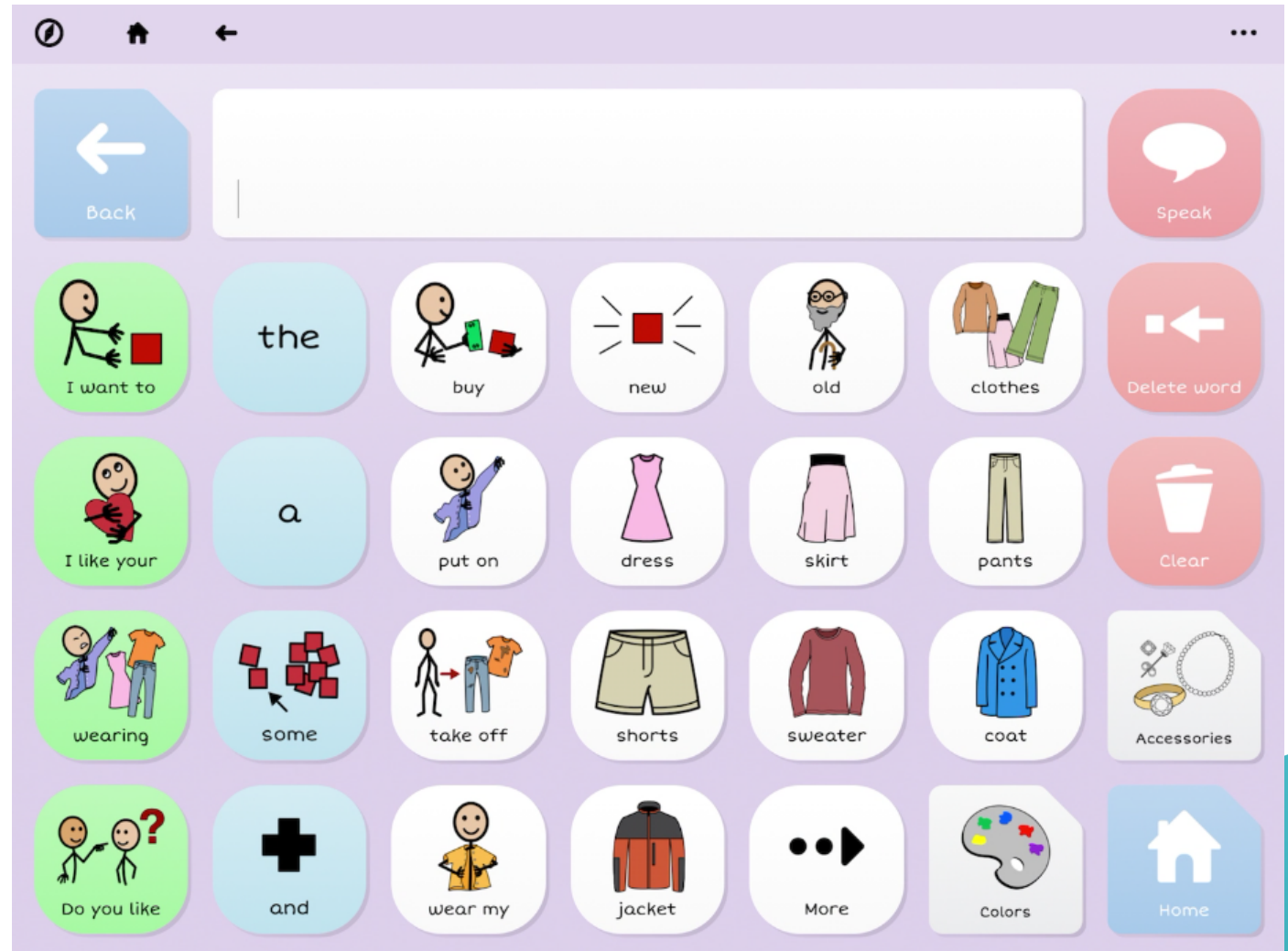

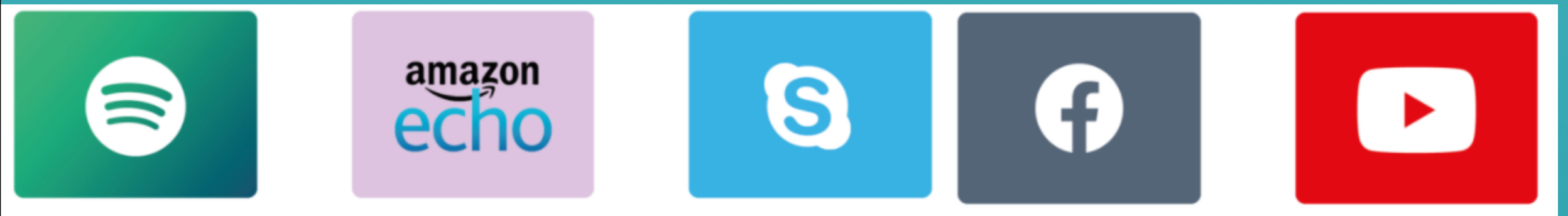

- Access to control other applications, the computer and the environment



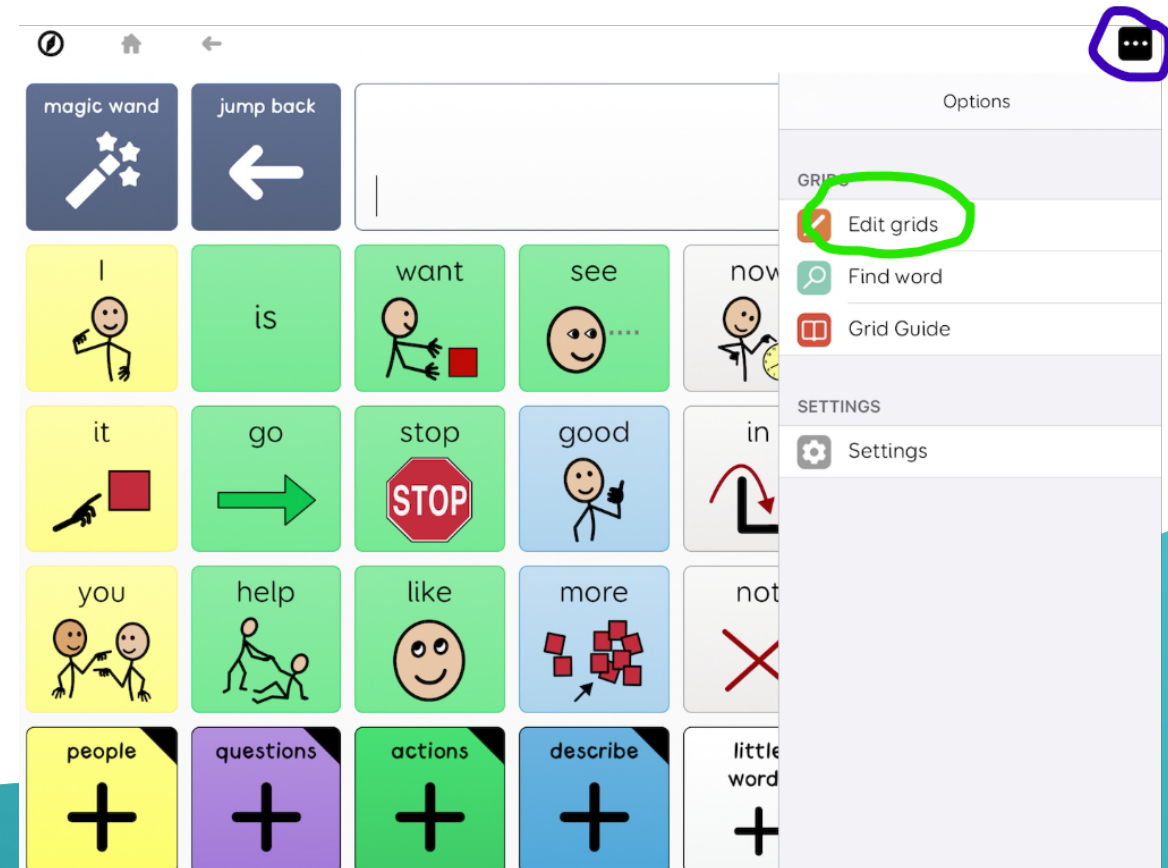
Access to amazon echo also available on Grid for iPad



Can connect to any device with infrared and radio technology

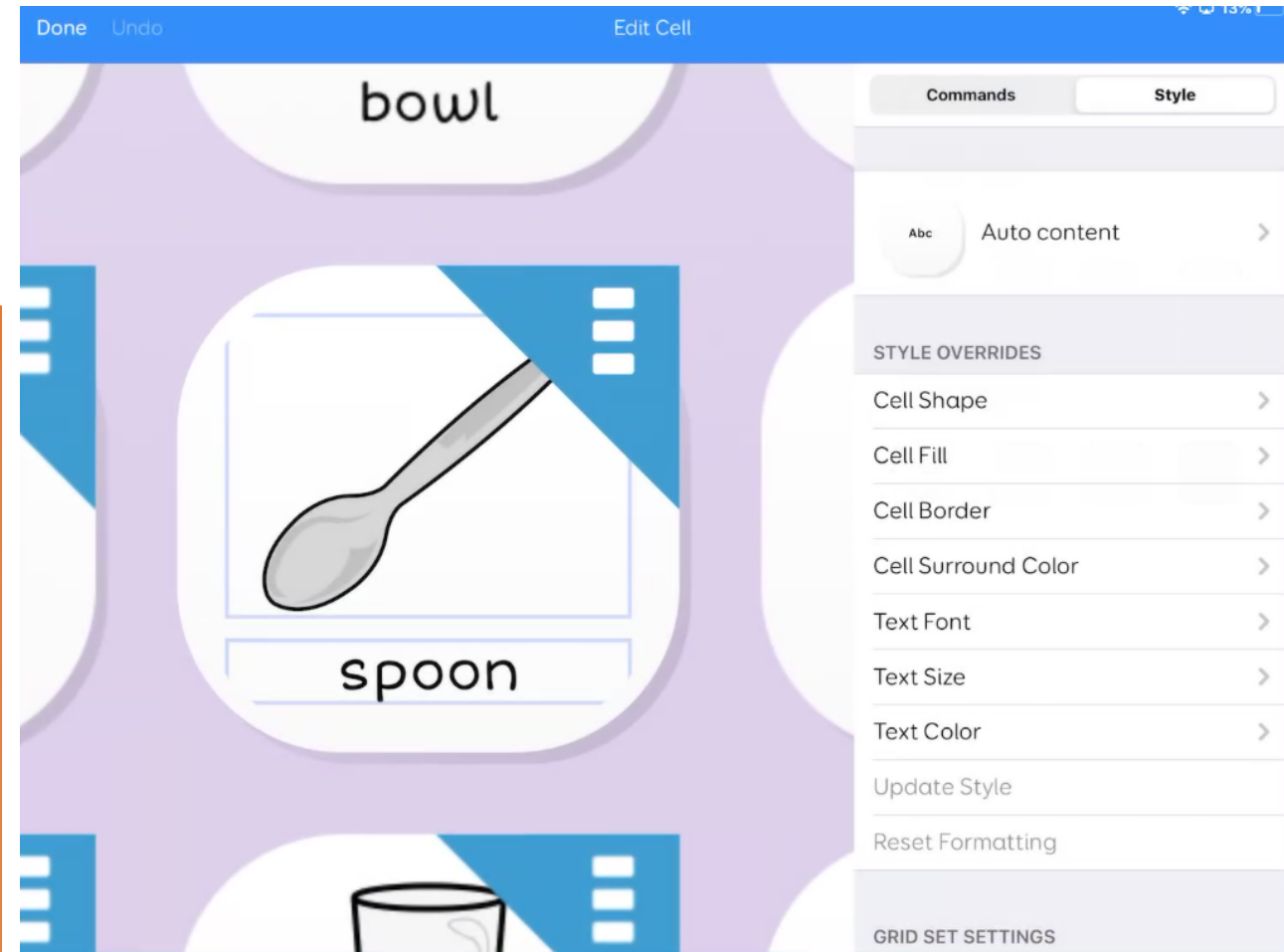
# How to edit

- You can edit in the app or remotely via a different device or a windows pc
- **Edit mode** by pressing **F11** or using the drop-down menu in the top left and selecting **Edit Grid**.
  - Move cells
  - Resize sell
  - Add cells
  - Change the writing or the pictures



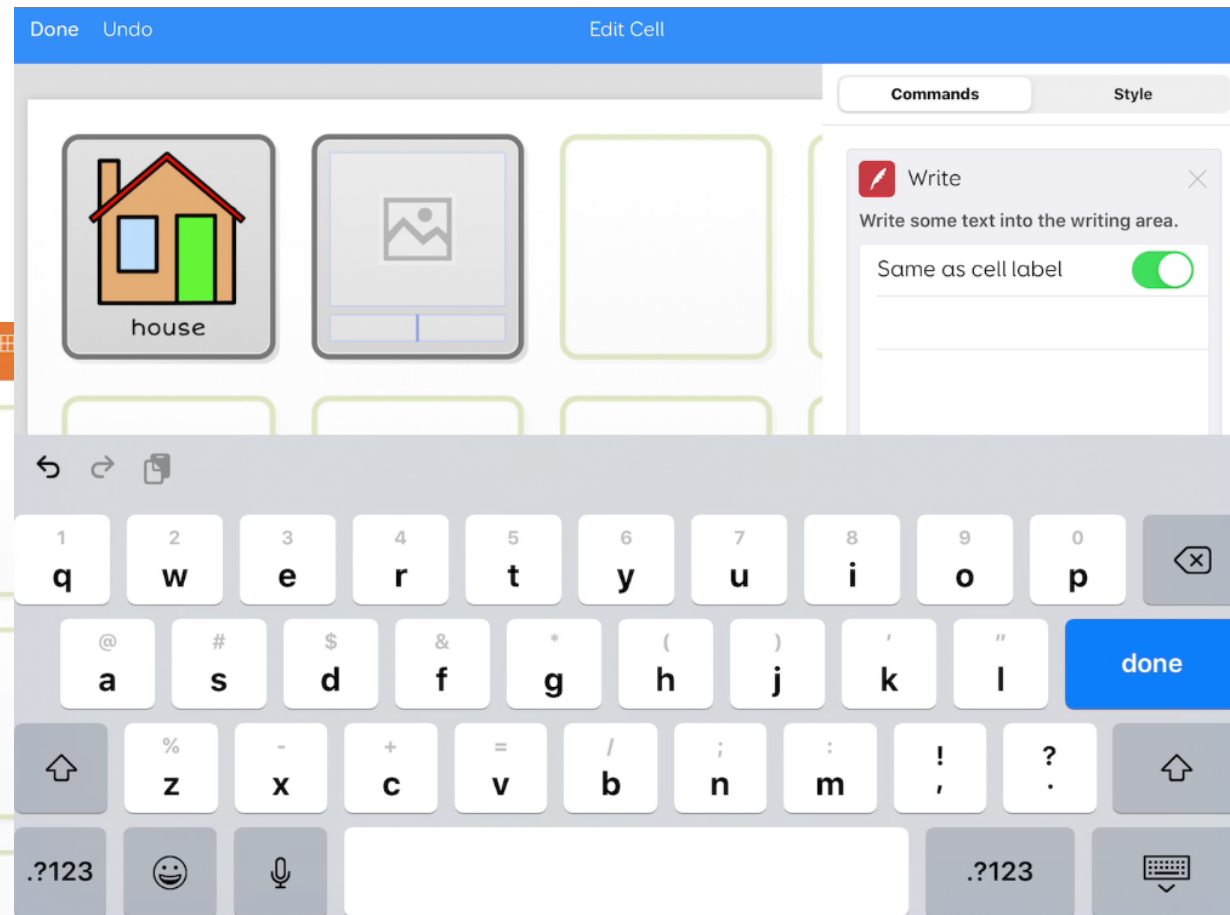
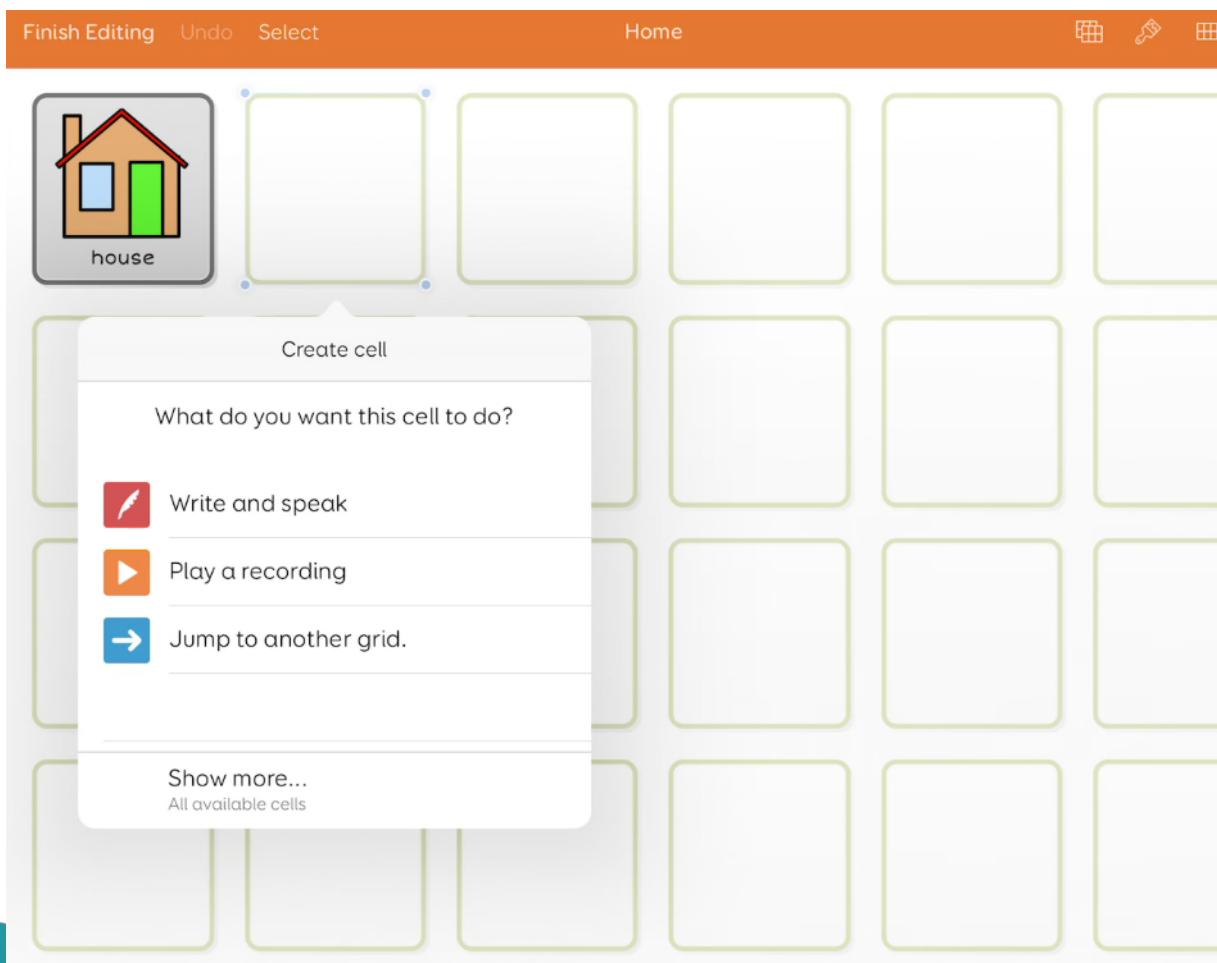

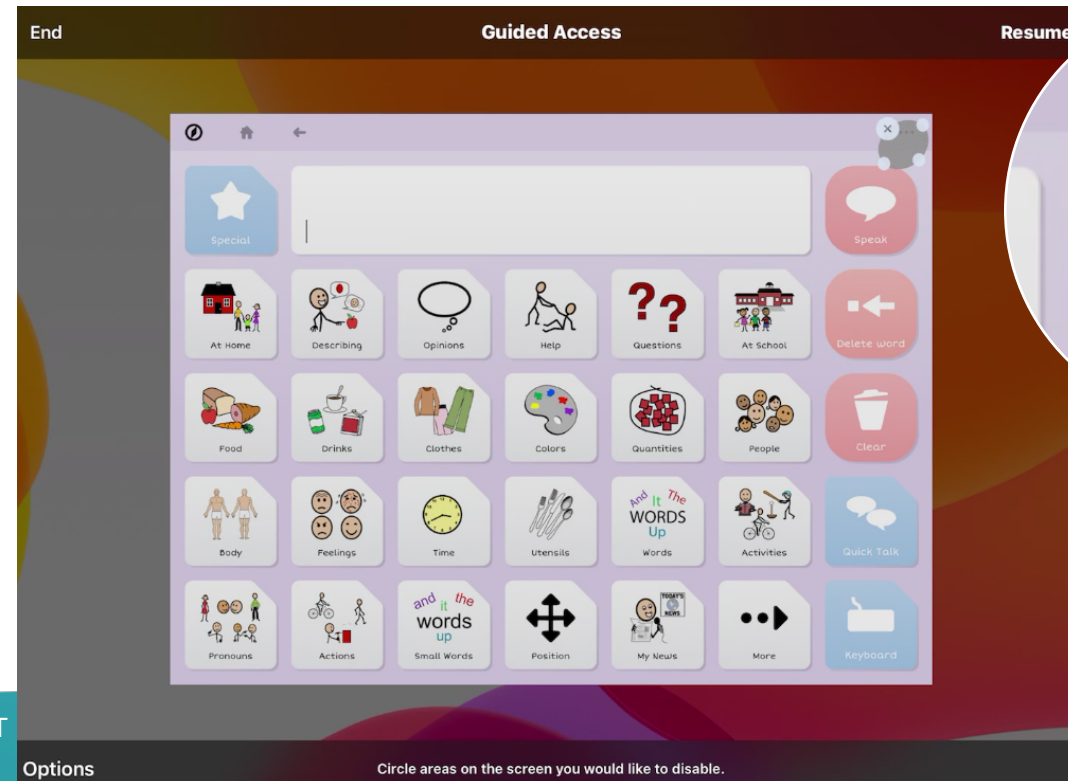


# Restrictions – Options within Grid 3

- You are able to hide the menu bar which should prevent access to edit mode and help deter minimizing of the Grid 3 app
  - Menu > settings > startup
- Return the menu bar by pressing 2 corners or by pressing F12

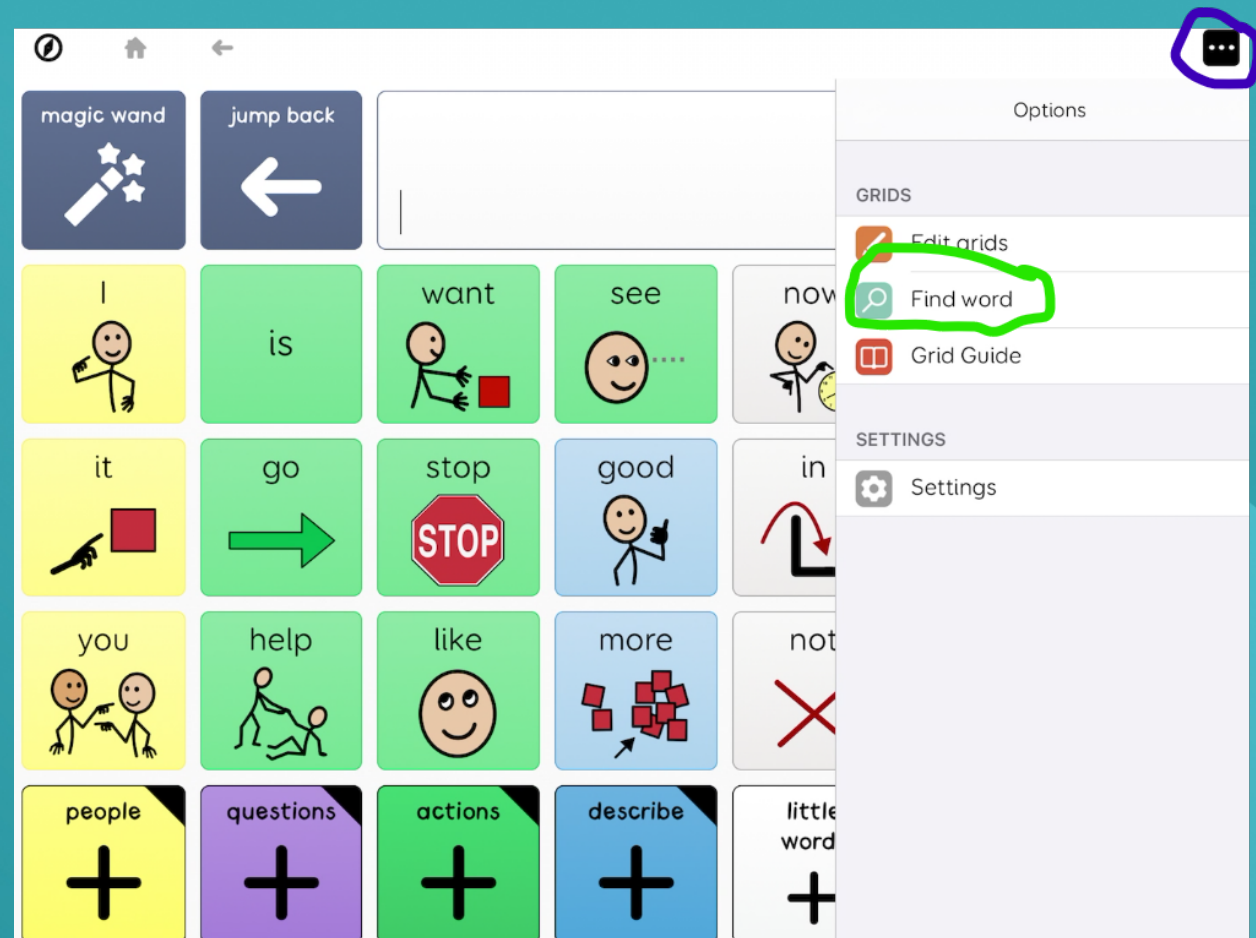
# Restrictions – Guided Access on the iPad

- Guided Access restricts the use of the iPad to a single application
  - Settings > Accessibility > Guided Access > turn on Guided Access
- Guided access can also allow you to restrict certain areas of the screen – you can use this to restrict access to the menu button essentially disabling the edit features



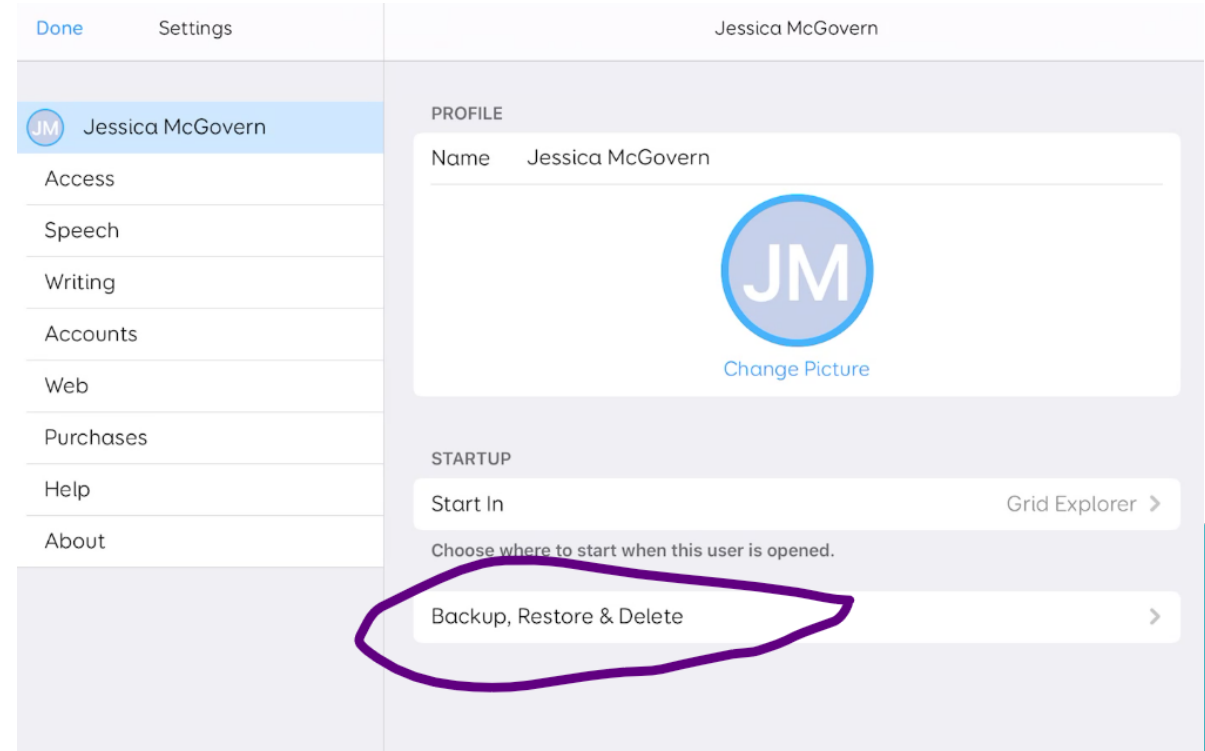
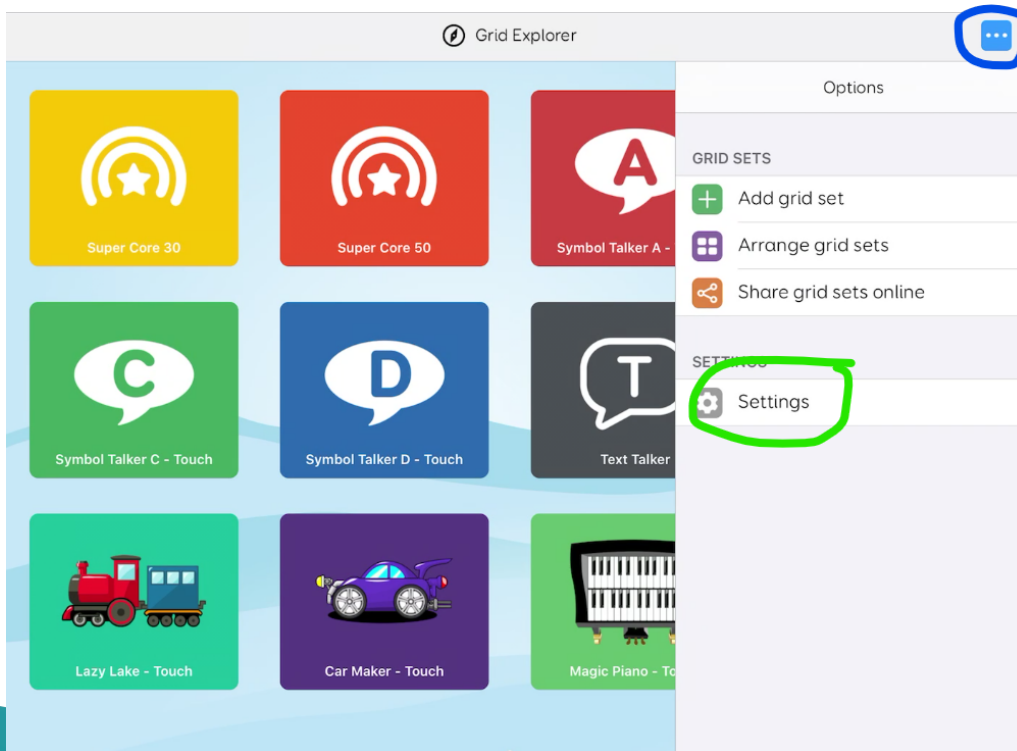
# Wordfinder and Search

- To quickly find which grid a word is on, click on the Menu bar and Find Word.



# Backup

- Connect account to Dropbox
- When you set up your account you can set up Dropbox and connect the accounts
