- 1. Identify Host Site varied departments for internships opportunities
- Identify fiscal resources typically reallocation of existing resources
- 3. Select Partners Adult Support Agencies
- Confirm eligibility and selection criteria
  Contract with SEARCH for Training, Materials and Fidelity Checks
- Hire and train staff (teacher, job coaches)
- Interview and selection process for participants skill assessment
- Train and support work site department heads natural supports
- Set up space for (community) classes
