- ❖ Play based and Trauma-focused intervention with children
- ❖ Involvement and collaboration with the Westchester County Department of Social Services
- ❖ Assessment/training/research in early childhood disabilities/autism spectrum disorders
- ❖ Training in the *Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule, Second Edition (ADOS-2)*
- ❖ Evidence-based behavioral interventions to adults and children with autism and developmental disabilities, with challenging behavior and/or mental health needs
